Access provides door-to-door service within Davidson County with a 24-hour advance reservation.</i> The standard paratransit ride fare is \$3.70 per one-way trip. Passengers may be required to travel with a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) at no charge. <i>Access on Demand (AOD) is an additional service offered to Access customers that gives them the option of booking a ride with the provider of their choice as few as two hours in advance. Service operates from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.</i> To schedule a trip using AOD, customers should call 615-862-5678. A trip must be scheduled a minimum of two hours in advance or at most 30 days in advance. Cost is \$7 for a trip up to 14 miles from the starting location. For a trip 14 miles or more from your starting location, you will be charged a \$1 for every additional mile. Trips are paid at the time of booking by credit or debit card.
